1754–1763	French and Indian War
1763	Proclamation of 1763 7,500-10,000 Troops left in North America
1765	First Constitutional Battle: Stamp Act Crisis Virginia Resolves Stamp Act Congress, New York Whatley: Virtual Representation Dulany: Against Virtual Representation
1766	Repeal of Stamp Act Passage of the Declaratory Act (same day)
1767	Second Constitutional Battle: Townshend Duties John Dickinson, <i>Letters from a Farmer in Pennsylvania</i> Customs Commissioners arrive in Boston
1768	Colonial Boycott of British Goods British Troops Arrive in Boston
1770	Boston "Massacre" Repeal of Townshend Duties (Except on Tea) Colonial Boycott collapses
1770-1773	Colonials resume good commercial relations with England Import tax on tea paid
1772	British Troops leave Boston
1773	Third Constitutional Battle: Tea Act Boston Tea Party
1774	Coercive Acts
